The Problem

- Critical caregiver shortages for vulnerable seniors
- Unpredictable and rising gas prices
- Food deserts: this lack of access to fresh, healthy food contributes to poor diets and leads to obesity and chronic diseases such as diabetes and heart disease.
- A lack of transportation services fitted for large amounts of goods and groceries.

The Solution

By first attacking the lack of transportation to grocery stores in a program that utilizes volunteers and pays for gas reimbursement we are able to decrease program costs dramatically.

The Result

- Increased mobility to farmers' markets, grocery stores and pharmacies.
- Promoting independent living for seniors and people living with disabilities.
- Passengers benefit from new relationships and increased support networks in vulnerable housing complexes.

Impact and Scalability

Each donation of 250.00 provides the gas for up to 100 rides.

Each donation of \$40,000 provides the program to 10 more vulnerable housing complexes for one year.
