Girls Rock Lab

Grades 3-8 • Join a band, write your own music, and play in a concert! Girls Rock Lab provides workshops, mentors, and a space where underrepresented genders in the music industry are empowered leaders and collaborators. We welcome girls, non-binary, and transgender kids from any identity or background to participate.
